Youth Work

What is the Youth Work Program?

Taking part in the Youth Work program will involve volunteering at the Gendered Intelligence youth groups by supporting our Youth Group Leaders and creating a safe and supportive space for our young people. We run youth groups for a wide range of ages from our Under 12s group, our 16-20 group and our under 21s groups in Leeds and Bristol. There are also opportunities to help out at our events for young people like camps!

It is ideal for volunteers based in London, Leeds and Bristol or who can travel to one of those locations for one of the monthly groups.

What's involved?

- Engaging with the young people and encouraging their participation.
- Help the lead workers with setting up and tidying up the space.
- Assist with the planning and delivery of sessions.
- Working collaboratively with a team of volunteers and GI staff.
- Other duties as assigned.

What will I get out of it?

- Youth work experience that will be useful if you are considering a career working with young people.
- Experience working with a team to create and present activities.
- Opportunity to utilise existing skills and develop new ones.
- Opportunity to meet other members of the community and make friends at our volunteer social events.
- All volunteers receive access to our in-house training and CPD program.
